### **UNDER SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES**

The opening event of the Junges Forum Israel was scheduled for May 11th 2021 in the Israeli-German Chamber of Commerce in Tel Aviv (AHK). A day that started like any other day left me full of doubts when it ended. Was it really the right time to open the Junges Forum?

In the AHK, we met the presidium of IDG and discussed our mutual goals. Later on we joined a language exchange event (Stammtisch) organized by the DAAD (German academic exchange service) in a café nearby. There was an optimistic atmosphere surrounding our new initiative till the sound of sirens burst –

We returned home safe but confused as we had to put our plans on hold. However, it took less than a day when international media channels seemed to reach new levels of one sided views about the operation without relating to the Israeli position. It became clear that the forum should immediately start operating.

### **OUR VISION**

The forum's vision is to strengthen the relations between young adults in Israel and Germany and it aims to contribute in its activities to maintain strong ties between the two societies. Our activities are divided into two main pillars: The first one is initiating events and projects that feature social, cultural and historical themes of both societies and working closely with our well-established partners in Germany: The German-Israeli Association (DIG) and its **Junges Forum**. The second pillar is to organize various social gatherings for our members and supporters. By these activities, we strive to develop a new community and platform in Israel for young Israelis and Germans who share interest in both countries and would like to promote their relations.

However, one cannot overlook Israel and Germany's shared history, which includes humanity's darkest chapters ever. The holocaust has a fundamental influence over the relations between the two states, and yet it seems astonishing how over the years Israel and Germany turned to be such strong allies.

Commemorating the events of the holocaust and struggling against hostile acts against Jews is an integral part of the forum's values.

### **ACHIEVEMENTS**

Our dedicated members have already contributed great efforts to this self-sufficient initiative. The forum is solely based on voluntary participation and yet the achievements that were reached till now indicate the commitment of the forum's members.

In these three months we successfully hosted two meetings, the re-opening event on May 11th and a picnic meet-up on July 29th in Park HaYarkon.

Moreover, we developed the platform by launching a new website including a blog, Facebook and Instagram pages, by designing flyers and our new official logo and we are pleased to learn every day that more and more people are interested in following our channels.
